2. Register and input your student information and law school. NOTE: YOU MUST USE YOUR LAW SCHOOL PROVIDED EMAIL ADDRESS. For example, [student.name@lawschool.edu](mailto:student.name@lawschool.edu); and
3. You will receive an email within 10–15 minutes. The email will contain instructions on how to verify your email address and once verified you will have unlimited access to the AudioCaseFiles library, which means that you will be able to download any case that AudioCaseFiles offers, without charge.
